Peter Becker, Professor and Chair of the Chromatin Dynamics and Nuclear Function group at <u>Lüdwig-Maximilians Universität München</u>, Munich, Germany

Peter B. Becker studied Biology at the University of Heidelberg and did his PhD research with Günther Schütz at the German Cancer Research Center. He then pursued post-doctoral studies with Carl Wu at the National Cancer Institute of the NIH (US) in between 1988-1991. For the next eight years Peter headed a research group at the European Molecular Biology Laboratory focusing on chromatin dynamics. In the year 1999 he became Chair of the Molecular Biology Department in the Medical Faculty of the Ludwig-Maximilians-University in Munich, where he works since then. Peter Becker's research focuses on energy-consuming nucleosome remodeling factors and on the mechanisms governing chromosome-wide transcriptional regulation during the process of dosage compensation in Drosophila.
