

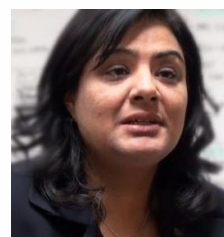

Arpana Verma is currently a Senior Lecturer in Public Health at the University of Manchester and Honorary Consultant in the NHS. She graduated in medicine from the University of Manchester in 1995 and worked as a respiratory physician until moving to public health in 2003. She has a PhD, Masters in Public Health and is a Member of the Faculty of Public Health in the UK. She is the principal investigator and coordinator of the European Urban Health Indicator System project (EURO-URHIS) and has set up the Manchester Urban Collaboration on Health (MUCH). She is also president of the Urban Health section for the European Public Health Association – EUPHA. Her research interests include urban health, health protection projects including: blood borne viruses, respiratory health, infection control, vaccinations and immunizations, and health services research including Population Impact Measures, respiratory medicine, cancer and adult cystic fibrosis. Her teaching activities include leading the Public Health development of the undergraduate medical curriculum at the University of Manchester, teaching on other undergraduate and postgraduate programmes and postgraduate training.
