George Morris, Environmental Public Health Advisor, Scotland, United Kingdom

Throughout a career in environment and human health, George Morris has worked in local government, in academia at the Universities of Strathclyde and Glasgow and as a Consultant in the UK's National Health Service. When seconded to the office of Scotland's Chief Medical Officer as a Scientific Policy Adviser he led development of "Good Places, Better Health", a new national policy approach on environment and human health. Most recently George's work has focused on navigating complexity in environmental public health and the challenges of building population health on ecological principles. Between 2009 and 2011 he held the post of "Consultant in Ecological Public Health" with Scotland's national health improvement agency before leaving to pursue an independent career. He continues to act as an adviser to various European institutions and was recently appointed Honorary Professor with the European Centre for Environment and Human Health.
