Samuel Coenen (ResearcherID A-6410-2011) is professor at the University of Antwerp and head of the Centre for General Practice, collaborating closely with the Vaccine & Infectious Disease Institute (VAXINFECTIO). His research focuses on the multidisciplinary study of infectious diseases, particularly on the management of respiratory tract infections in primary care in the context of antimicrobial resistance. He was granted several Fellowships by the Research Foundation-Flanders, and an Honorary Research Fellowship by Cardiff University. He is member of the Management Team, partner, or collaborator in several European projects (DG Sanco, FP6, FP7, ECDC, ESF), e.g. ESAC (European Surveillance of Antimicrobial Surveillance), and chairs the BAPCOC (Belgian Antibiotic Policy Coordination Committee) Working Party responsible for the Belgian public campaign on appropriate antibiotic use.
