Carlo Reggiani

Carlo Reggiani is presently Full Professor of Physiology at University of Padova (Italy). The position implies teaching students of the Medical School and of the Exercise and Sport Science Courses. He is also director of Sport Medicine School at the same University. CR received his medical degree in 1972 at the University of Pavia (Italy). At the University of Pavia, he was appointed Associate Professor of Physiology in 1983 after a stay at the University of Lund (Sweden), in the laboratory of Prof. P. Edman (1980-1983). In 1991 he became Full Professor at the University of Pavia and in 2000 he was called to the University of Padova. The scientific activity of CR has been devoted to the physiology and biophysics of skeletal and cardiac muscle with two main subjects: the relations between myofibrillar proteins and their isoforms with contractile performance and the regulation of myofibrillar protein expression in relation to specific functional conditions. The results are collected in 145 papers with 4200 citations. Research activity has been funded by European Union grants, Telethon (Italian charity fund), Italian ministry of university and research (MIUR) and ASI (Italian Space Agency).

Carlo Reggiani is member of the editorial board of J. Physiol, Am J Physiol-Cell Physiol, BMC Physiology.
