He sits on a number of editorial boards and serves as a reviewer for multiple journals. Member of numerous national and international organizations including the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American Pediatric Society, the American Medical Association, the American Thoracic Society, the European Society for Pediatric Research, the International Academy of Perinatal Medicine, the American Board of Pediatrics and the Sub-Board of Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine. He has served in several NICHD and NHLBI External Advisory Committees. Dr Bancalari directed the Neonatal Training Program at Jackson Memorial Hospital for more than 35 years and has supervised the training of more than 150 neonatologists who practice in different countries around the world. Dr. Bancalari has been honored with the University of Miami School of Medicine Dean's Research Award for Career Achievement, the Project Newborn Distinguished Chair in Neonatology, the Duane Alexander Award for Academic Leadership in Perinatal Medicine, and the Robert Zeppa M.D. Award of Excellence. Dr. Bancalari lectures extensively, worldwide and has participated in multiple research projects funded by the NIH and other extramural sources.
