W. Hamish Wallace Consultant Paediatric Oncologist, RHSC, Edinburgh since 1992. Reader in the Department of Reproductive and Developmental Sciences at the University of Edinburgh. St George's Hospital Medical School in 1980. Trained in paediatric oncology at Great Ormond Street, Birmingham, Edinburgh. MD.,FRCP., FRCPC.,FRCS He became a Leukaemia Research Fund Research Fellow under the guidance of Professor Steve Shalet in Manchester in the late 1980s when he developed his research interest in the late endocrine effects of the treatment of childhood cancer and completed my MD thesis. His main research interest is in fertility prediction and preservation for cancer patients. Chair of the CCLG Hodgkin's Lymphoma Working Group (since 2002) and President of the European Network for Paediatric Hodgkin's Lymphoma (since 2007). Directs the HEBA Research Centre in Edinburgh which is committed to ongoing research into the effects of the treatment of childhood cancer on fertility, bone health and the vascular endothelium. Co-author of over 110 peer reviewed publications, and four books. Most recently co-edited with Prof Dan Green a multi-author book on "Late effects of the treatment of Childhood Cancer" and with Prof Chris Kelnar a book on "Endocrine complications of the treatment of childhood cancer". Co-founder and organiser for ESLCCC, a biannual conference on the late effects of the treatment of childhood cancer. Appointed Lead Clinician for the Children's and Young Peoples MCN for Cancer in Scotland "CATSCAN" in November 2007. Most recently he has agreed to chair a SIGN guideline on the late complications of the treatment of childhood cancer, which will build on the work of an earlier guideline SIGN 76, which he chaired and was published in 2004.
