

Jacques Donnez

Professor **Jacques Donnez** studied medicine and completed his internship in gynecology and obstetrics at the Université Catholique de Louvain (UCL). His subsequent research career there has been devoted to identifying and understanding the molecular and pathophysiological mechanisms underlying female infertility and the development of new therapeutic options to restore or preserve women's health and fertility. In 1984 he defended his PhD thesis "The Fallopian tube: normal and pathological histophysiology" and then went on to found the Infertility Research Unit at UCL, becoming Head and Chairman of the Department of Gynaecology in 1986. His areas of interest are pelvic surgery, endometriosis and research on ovarian cryopreservation and transplantation. Prof. Jacques Donnez is Doctor Honoris Causa, Sun Yat-Sen University of Medical Sciences, Guangzhou, Canton, China (2000) and he was the President of International Society for Fertility Preservation (2007-2010).
