After staying in Eric Richards lab in Washington University during 1992-1994 as a post-doctoral fellow, he organized his own group in National Institute of Agrobiological Resources in Tsukuba, Japan. He moved to NIG in 2000, and became a professor in 2005. He has been investigating biological roles and controlling mechanisms of DNA methylation using *Arabidopsis* as a model organism
