Postgraduate degrees: Pediatrics; Neonatal Pathology and Intensive Care; Health Organization with full marks at the Verona University School of Medicine and Surgery. From 2003 Associate Professor of Pediatrics, University of Cagliari. Board member of the Italian Society of Neonatology for 9 years (6 Secretary, 3 treasurer). Founder, Past Executive Board Member and Scientific Officer UENPS (Union European Neonatal Perinatal Societies), past Board member UMENS (Union MEditerranean Neonatal Societies). Member of the National Pediatric Commission on Risk Management. Winner of awards in National and International meetings. Member of the European Workshop of Neonatology and of the International Perinatal Collegium. Coordinator of several multicentre clinical researches in neonatology. Last grant: 198.500 euros from Italian Ministry of Health (1st winner among 245 projects) on metabolomics and sepsis. Area of scientific interest: nephrology, pharmacology, infections, laboratory medicine, pathology, metabolomics. 49 collaborations in metabolomics with 11 countries. Editor in Chief of Journal of Pediatric and Neonatal Individualized Medicine, board member in 7 International Journals and referee of 30 International Journals. Speaker in more than 300 Congresses (>100 International). Organizer of more than 55 Congresses and International Workshops on Neonatology (8 in Cagliari). Author of over 500 publications (of which 234 on Pub Med) in National and International Journals. Author of 264 free communications and posters (of which 113 presented in International Meetings). Author of 17 books (the last two: Developmental Nephrology: from embryology to metabolomics with R.L. Chevalier), Perinatal Pharmacology: tailored neonatal therapy with J. Aranda and J. van den Anker), 12 Proceedings of Congresses, Guest Editor in many Journals, Author of several chapters (66) in International (22) and National (44) books.
